The regular meeting of the Commissioner of Pulaski County was held at 10:00 a.m., August 3, 2015 for the purpose of attending to the affairs of Pulaski County as related to the Commissioner's office.

Commissioner Hall led attendees in the pledge of allegiance.

Immediately following the pledge of allegiance, Commissioner Hall asked City Commissioner, Shelly Berryhill, to give the invocation.

The first item of business was to hear from Archway. Michelle Elliott went over a list of community changes and accomplishments that have taken place in the last four years.

The second item of business was to hear a report from the Sheriff's Office. Sheriff Cape stated that there are 25 in jail, 51 civil papers had been served and 98 tickets written.

The third item of business was to hear a report from Public Safety. Leslie Sewell was not in attendance.

The fourth item of business was to hear a report from United Pulaski. Lee Slade was not in attendance.

The fifth item of business was for the Commissioner to sign a Memorandum of Agreement between the city, the county and Middle Georgia Regional Commission concerning the development of a multi-unit website. The agreement is on file.

The sixth item of business was for the Commissioner to sign a Third-Party Agreement with Middle Georgia Community Action Agency regarding the Transit 5311 program. The agreement is on file.

The seventh item of business was for the Commissioner to sign a contract with the Georgia Department of Transportation concerning the Transit 5311 program. The agreement is on file.


The eighth item of business was for the Commissioner to sign a Resolution regarding the Transportation Investment Act. A copy of the Resolution follows and is on file.

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, the Transportation Investment Act of 2010 established the ability of each service delivery region in Georgia to levy a sales tax for the purposes of funding transportation infrastructure improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, the Middle Georgia region consisting of Baldwin, Crawford, Houston, Jones, Macon-Bibb, Monroe, Peach, Pulaski, Putnam, Twiggs and Wilkinson counties implemented the requirements of the Transportation Investment Act of 2010 and voters considered but did not approve a sales tax referendum on July 31, 2012; and

**WHEREAS**, the Transportation Funding Act of 2015 was signed by Governor Nathan Deal on May 4, 2015 and provided a mechanism for regions that did not pass the referendum in 2012 to reconsider the question upon adoption of a resolution by the governing bodies of a majority of the counties in the region; and

**WHEREAS**, all of the procedural requirements of the Transportation Investment Act of 2010 remain in effect regarding the creation of investment criteria, the establishment of the Regional Roundtable and Executive Committee, the development of a draft investment list, and public participation among other items; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Pulaski County Commissioner desires to initiate the process outlined in the Transportation Investment Act of 2010 for the voters of the Middle Georgia region to consider the imposition of a one cent sales tax for the purposes of funding transportation infrastructure improvements in the region; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a copy of this resolution shall be transmitted to the Director of Planning of the Georgia Department of Transportation, the Middle Georgia Regional Commission as well as the Boards of Commission of the counties of Middle Georgia.

Minutes of Millage Rate Setting Meeting


A meeting was held at 10:00 a.m., August 6, 2015 for the purpose of setting the 2015 millage rate for Pulaski County.
