

Minutes of Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of the Commissioner of Pulaski County was held at 10:00 a.m., September 8, 2015 for the purpose of attending to the affairs of Pulaski County as related to the Commissioner's office.

Commissioner Hall led attendees in the pledge of allegiance.

Immediately following the pledge of allegiance, Commissioner Hall asked City Manager, Tim Young, to give the invocation.

The first item of business was to hear from Archway. Michelle Elliott stated that the Youth Leadership had collected books to be distributed at the local pediatrics office. The books will be distributed to children receiving Well Child Checks. Mrs. Elliott also stated that Life League partnered with the basketball coach at the local high school to form a breakfast club for kids. She also mentioned that a Suicide Prevention Initiative is taking place in the community to inform and educate the community about suicide.

The second item of business was to hear a report from the Sheriff's Office. No one from the Sheriff's office was in attendance due to court being held.

The third item of business was to hear a report from Public Safety. Leslie Sewell stated that August had been a quiet month with a few brush fires and a car fire. He stated that there had not been a structure fire in the last 30 days. He also stated that he is currently working on having another fire sub-station erected in the northern part of the county.

The fourth item of business was to hear a report from United Pulaski. Lee Slade spoke about regionalism and the upcoming Harvest Fest that will be taking place on October 24. He also spoke about the Central Georgia Joint Development Authority. Pulaski County will be joining this authority at no cost to the taxpayers.

The fifth item of business was for the Commissioner to formally donate the lift station and components of the sewage system in the Forest Hill Circle Subdivision to the City of Hawkinsville. This is effective as of January 1, 2015. The total cost was \$534,137.

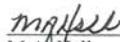
The sixth item of business was for the Commissioner to approve the closing of a bank account at SunMark Community Bank. Account #1116729 is for the Pulaski County Recreation 2010 SPLOST. The account has a zero balance and will be closed.

The seventh item of business was for the Commissioner to make an appointment to the Recreation Board. Allison Meeks was re-appointed with a term ending 9/9/2018.

The eighth item of business was to hear floor comments. City Manager, Tim Young, stated that the City Commissioner meeting would be held on September 14th at 6:00 p.m. Chuck Southerland stated that the Georgia Conservancy paddle group would be in Hawkinsville November 6th-8th. He stated that he would need some help getting the park cleaned up in October.

Present for this Commissioner's meeting was Michelle Elliott, Tim Young, Leslie Sewell, Kelly McWilliams, Lee Slade, Mark Freeman, Chuck Southerland, Sara Myers, and Commissioner Hall.

There being no further business to come before the Commissioner, the meeting was duly adjourned.
