

Minutes of Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of the Commissioner of Pulaski County was held at 10:00 a.m., February 1, 2016 for the purpose of attending to the affairs of Pulaski County as related to the Commissioner's office.

Commissioner Hall led attendees in the pledge of allegiance.

Immediately following the pledge of allegiance, Commissioner Hall asked City Manager, Tim Young, to give the invocation.

The first item of business was to hear from Archway. Michelle Elliott stated that the Youth Leadership class was getting ready to take a trip to the state capitol on 2/17/16. She mentioned that they were currently collecting books for the doctor's office. She also brought up the Adult Leadership class going on. She stated that the Pulaski Tomorrow Golf Tournament will be on April 16 and the 3rd Teen Maze will be on 4/21/16.

The second item of business was to hear a report from the Sheriff's Office. Sheriff Billy Cape stated that there were 34 currently in jail, 54 civil papers served and 72 citations written. He also mentioned that he is working on burglaries, armed robberies, and home invasion case going on.

The third item of business was to hear a report from Public Safety. Leslie Sewell stated that it was a busy month in January. There were a couple of house fires and the fire department had to help with river cleanup.

The fourth item of business was to hear a report from United Pulaski. Lee Slade stated that he currently has two active projects, one of which he is working with Tim Young on. He will be attending an Archway Summit in Athens later this month. There is a Big River event planned for May. The details will come later.

The fifth item of business was for the Commissioner to make an appointment to the Tax Assessor Board. Gary Dawson and Maye Gentry were both re-appointed to a six year term that will end 03/08/2021.


The sixth item of business was to hear floor comments. Donna Rickerson spoke for the Chamber of Commerce and gave a brief summary of events that have taken place.
