

Minutes of Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of the Commissioner of Pulaski County was held at 10:00 a.m., May 2, 2016 for the purpose of attending to the affairs of Pulaski County as related to the Commissioner's office.

Commissioner Hall led attendees in the pledge of allegiance.

Immediately following the pledge of allegiance, Commissioner Hall asked City Commissioner, Shelly Berryhill, to give the invocation.

The first item of business was to hear from Archway. Michelle Elliot spoke about the Teen Maze and stated that nearly 600 students participated and close to 200 people volunteered to help. She also mentioned various events happening that week, including working on workforce development with middle school students, the technical college and Taylor Regional Hospital.

The second item of business was to hear a report from the Sheriff's Office. Sheriff Billy Cape stated that there were 34 currently in jail, 43 civil papers served, and 54 citations written.

The third item of business was to hear a report from Public Safety. Leslie Sewell stated that March was a good month with no major house fires, but still a busy month. He also mentioned that the fire department helped out at the Teen Maze.

The fourth item of business was to hear a report from United Pulaski. Lee Slade was not in attendance.

The fifth item of business was for Commissioner Hall to adopt a resolution for a 1% SPLOST sales tax vote to be held November 8, 2016 instead of the original date of July 26, 2016.

The sixth item of business was for Commissioner Hall to sign an ordinance pertaining to midnight closing of establishments that have alcohol on the premises.


The seventh item of business was to hear floor comments. No one spoke at this time.
