

Minutes of Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of the Commissioner of Pulaski County was held at 10:00 a.m., June 6, 2016 for the purpose of attending to the affairs of Pulaski County as related to the Commissioner's office.

Commissioner Hall led attendees in the pledge of allegiance.

Immediately following the pledge of allegiance, Commissioner Hall asked City Manager, Tim Young, to give the invocation.

The first item of business was to hear from Archway. Michelle Elliot was not present.

The second item of business was to hear a report from the Sheriff's Office. Sheriff Billy Cape stated that there were 33 currently in jail, 37 civil papers served, and 77 citations written. He also stated that the Sheriff Department was working on several burglaries.

The third item of business was to hear a report from Public Safety. Leslie Sewell was not present.

The fourth item of business was to hear a report from United Pulaski. Lee Slade spoke positively about many of the projects he was currently working on, including the Ocmulgee Water Trail.

The fifth item of business was to hear the Chamber of Commerce report. Donna Rickerson spoke about many of the events happening this month, including Business After Hours at Taylor Regional Hospital, a Zika virus webinar, a Georgia Town Hall chamber meeting, and the Sheriff candidates forum being held at the Opera House on June 21st. She also mentioned that Way Brothers was the Business of the Month.

The sixth item of business was to hear from Mandy Young about housing in Pulaski County. She was not in attendance, so Ramsey Way spoke on her behalf. He asked Commissioner Hall to sign a resolution supporting the rehabilitation project of W.H. Mooney, Henry Way, and Georgia Wallace apartments as affordable housing residential family developments.

The seventh item of business was for Commissioner Hall to sign the resolution supporting the rehabilitation of the above apartments.


The eighth item of business was for Commissioner Hall to sign a resolution designating the month of June as Civitan Awareness Month.

The ninth item of business was for Commissioner Hall to sign a proclamation designating June 9th as Ralph Nix Day.


The tenth item of business was to hear floor comments. No one spoke at this time.
