

Minutes of Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of the Commissioner of Pulaski County was held at 10:00 a.m., June 5, 2017 for the purpose of attending to the affairs of Pulaski County as related to the Commissioner's office.

Commissioner Hall led attendees in the pledge of allegiance.

Immediately following the pledge of allegiance, Commissioner Hall asked Tim Young to give the invocation.

The first item of business was to hear from Archway. No one was present to give a report.

The second item of business was to hear a report from the Sheriff's Office. Sheriff Danny Brannen reported that there were currently 40 in the jail and there had been several drug arrest and DUI's. Sheriff Brannen also said that he had ordered some vest for the Sheriff's Department and he thanked the businesses who had donated money towards them.
