

Minutes of Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of the Commissioner of Pulaski County was held at 10:00 a.m., July 10, 2017 for the purpose of attending to the affairs of Pulaski County as related to the Commissioner's office.

Commissioner Hall led attendees in the pledge of allegiance.

Immediately following the pledge of allegiance, Commissioner Hall asked Tim Young to give the invocation.

The first item of business was to hear from Archway. No one was present to give a report.

The second item of business was to hear a report from the Sheriff's Office. Sheriff Danny Brannen reported that there had been a double murder in the county but the suspect had been caught and is in jail. He also stated that the Sheriff's Department had a new website and it was for information only. Sheriff Brannen also said that Kay Anderson was working on a grant for the department to be able to get 8 new police cars that will be fully equipped.

The third item of business was to hear a report from Public Safety. No one was present to give a report.

The fourth item of business was to hear from United Pulaski. No one was present to give a report.

The fifth item of business was to hear from the Chamber of Commerce. Donna Rickerson reported that there would be a ribbon cutting July 12th at 11:00 for Hokes Heating and Air and July 18th at 11:00 for Central Georgia Radio. She also said that Central Georgia Tech would be helping with a "Back to School Bash" giving away school supplies July 27, 2017 from 4:00 – 7:00

The sixth item of business was from the Board of Family and Children Services to re-appoint Robert Ross to a five year term to expire on June 30, 2022.

The seventh item of business was floor comments. Commissioner Hall gave a report that the twin bridges are still moving along on schedule. City Manager, Tim Young commented how good the mural on the State Farm building looked. He also stated that H&V's project was on schedule and should start making the product in January.
