

## Minutes of Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of the Commissioner of Pulaski County was held at 10:00 a.m., September 18, 2017 for the purpose of attending to the affairs of Pulaski County as related to the Commissioner's office.

Commissioner Hall led attendees in the pledge of allegiance.

The first item of business was to hear from the Sheriff's Office. No one was present to give a report.

The second item of business was to hear a report from Public Safety. Fire Chief, Leslie Sewell stated that hurricane IRMA created a lot of chaos. He praised all of the city and county workers and agencies who worked diligently through the night assisting those in need. He stated that just about every road leading to Hawkinsville was blocked Monday and that there were a lot of power outages leaving some residents without power 4 to 5 days but was very thankful that there were no injuries reported due to the storm. There is still a lot of work to be done and asked that people just be patient.

The third item of business was to hear a report from Chamber of Commerce. No one was present to give a report.

The fourth item of business was to amend the 2016 Budget. The amendment was adopted and approved by Commissioner Hall. A copy of the amended budget follows and is on file.

The fifth item of business was to sign a two year contract between the GACD and Pulaski County. Commissioner Hall approved the contract.

The sixth item of business, Commissioner Hall presented a Proclamation for Literacy Month designating the month of September Literacy Month and encouraged the citizens of Pulaski County to actively support the organization. A copy of the Proclamation follows and is on file.

The seventh item of business was floor comments. Commissioner Hall commended all agencies who worked in the midst of hurricane IRMA on a job well done. He said he was proud of the way everyone handled things. He then gave a report that the twin bridges are still moving along on schedule. Ken Clark asked that every be patient as they are trying to get all of the debris picked up from the side of the roads and hoped to have it all gone by the end of the week.

There being no further business to come before the Commissioner, the meeting was duly adjourned.
