

Minutes of Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of the Commissioner of Pulaski County was held at 10:00 a.m., November 4, 2019 for the purpose of attending to the affairs of Pulaski County as related to the Commissioner's office.

Commissioner Mashburn led in the Pledge of Allegiance and Dr. Skip McDannald gave the invocation. The first item of business was to hear a report from Archway. Ms. Raleigh was not present but sent a report that there are 10 active projects in the community. The main ones are senior engineering students working on redesign of a potential new Senior Center and recruitment for new business downtown, possibly a microbrewery.

The second item of business was to hear a report from the Sheriff's Office. No one was present.

The third item of business was to hear a report from Public Safety. No one was present.

The fourth item of business was discussion regarding the rezoning of Michigan Peat at 131 Firetower Rd from residential to mixed use. The plant is open for business with 20 truckload a week and 75% of the work done by local people. The plant hopes to be able to offer 15 jobs to start with plans to double the amount and also work with the school for possible apprenticeships. Brandon Wiggins is the plant manager and Mitch Aultman is the maintenance manager.

The fifth item of business was signing of a resolution to authorize Georgia Department of Transportation to file their annual grant for funding for the Pulaski Transit program. The application is filed under Title 49 U.S.C., Section 5311. A public notice about the filing was published in the Hawkinsville Dispatch on November 4th.

The sixth item of business was to hear floor comments. Sandy White, Executive Development Director discussed the following events: Chamber of Commerce annual meeting 11/14/19, Downtown Open House with new branding rollout, car show and Christmas parade on 12/7/19. A new 12 foot tree is being purchased from Bold Springs Nursery to be planted outside courthouse and lit for Christmas on 11/30/19.


John Green, CEO of Taylor Regional, offered assistance with occupational health needs for Michigan Peat.
