

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Hawkinsville, Georgia met in a Regular Meeting Monday December 7, 2020 at City Hall at 6:00 p.m. with Chairman Shelly Berryhill presiding.

PRESENT: Chairman Shelly Berryhill, Henry Cravey, James Colson, Ken Hardy and Ken Clark.

AGENDA: Shelly Berryhill motioned to approve the agenda and to move agenda item 9(h) up to item 9(a). Henry Cravey seconded; motion passed by a yes vote by all who were present. No oppositions.

MINUTES: James Colson motioned to approve the minutes of the November 2, 2020 Regular Meeting. Ken Hardy seconded; motion passed by a yes vote by all who were present. No oppositions.

NEW BUSINESS:

APPROVE: Leslie Sewell was in attendance representing the American Legion. He asked if American Flags could be placed in the right-of-way along Broad Street and/or Highway 341 for the July 4th and Veteran's Day holidays. He asked if city staff could locate the utilities in the right-of-way and help set the flags out with the help of the American Legion. The American Legion will be selling the flags as a fundraiser. They will remove the flags after the holiday and store the flags. Mr. Sewell stated that in the future the flags may also be placed along these streets for other holidays. James Colson motioned to approve this request. Shelly Berryhill seconded; motion passed by a yes vote by all who were present. No oppositions.

APPROVE: Business License Application(s): James Colson motioned to approve. Ken Hardy seconded, motion passed by a yes vote by all who were present. No oppositions.

APPROVE: Henry Cravey motioned to approve the Sunday alcohol sales and Sunday sales by the drink ordinance. Per the City Attorney, Jim Elliott, this ordinance only required one reading since the question had appeared on the November 3, 2020 ballot and was approved by voters. The ordinance will go into effect January 1, 2021. Ken Hardy seconded; motion passed by a yes vote by all who were present. No oppositions.

APPROVE: James Colson motioned to approve the Language Access Plan Resolution for the 2020 CDBG. Ken Hardy seconded; motion passed by yes vote by all who were present. No oppositions.



APPROVE: Shelly Berryhill motioned to approve the bid received by Brown Construction for the construction of a concession stand and restrooms at Colson Park in the amount of \$31,800. This was the only bid that was received out of the five contractors that were sent requests for proposals. Ken Clark seconded; motion passed by a yes vote by each commissioner with the exception of James Colson who abstained from the vote due to a conflict of interest.

APPROVE: Shelly Berryhill motioned to re-appoint Henry Cravey to the Middle Georgia Regional Commission Council for the year 2021. Ken Hardy seconded; motion passed by a yes vote by all who were present. No oppositions.

Susan Landfried with the Middle Georgia Regional Commission discussed the Comprehensive Planning Process with the Board of Commissioners. She asked that the Board have a list of names for the steering committee that would need to be formed in order to update the Plan. Shelly Berryhill asked Ms. Landfried to send the list of the last individuals that served on this committee. Ms. Landfried asked if the Board would please provide a list of individuals willing to serve on the steering committee by the January 2021 meeting.

ADJOURN: James Colson motioned to adjourn. Shelly Berryhill seconded; motion passed by a yes vote by all who were present. No oppositions.
