

Minutes of Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of the Commissioner of Pulaski County was held at 10:00 a.m., December 7, 2020 for the purpose of attending to the affairs of Pulaski County as related to the Commissioner's office.

Commissioner Mashburn led the Pledge of Allegiance and gave the invocation.

Agenda Items

- The Public Health State of Emergency from Governor Kemp is extended through January 8, 2020.
- The FY2021 Budget was approved for Pulaski County DFACS.
- The contract with Performance Pest Control-Cochran, GA was signed.
- The Appraisal Engagement Letter between Pulaski County Board of Tax Assessors and Charles B. Bramlett was signed.
- The Pledge Release Agreement with Sunmark Bank was signed.
- Resolution 2020-16 to authorize Tax Commissioner to waive taxes owed
- Resolution 2020-17 to authorize Tax Commissioner to sell property for less than taxes owed
- Resolution 2020-18 to authorize Tax Commissioner to waive certain penalties/interest
- Resolution 2020-19 to authorize Tax Commissioner to conduct Judicial In Rem Foreclosures
- Ordinance 2020-2 to amend Chapter 6 of the Code of Ordinances regarding alcoholic beverages.
- Susan Landfried of the Middle Georgia Regional Commission discussed the Comprehensive Planning Process (the timeline, background, assistance with mitigation and public engagement processes.)
- The County Personnel Policies & Procedures were revised and updated. Changes were made to the Social Media policy, Military Care Giver Leave and the Travel reimbursement policy was clarified.

Public Comments

Jon Green, CEO of Taylor Regional discussed the hospital receiving the COVID-19 vaccine and that Dr. Campbell was the point of contact. First to receive will be frontline workers and long-term care facilities patients. Although 90% of critical beds are occupied nationwide, our hospital was in good shape. There will be a blood drive at the hospital on December 17th.
