CITIZEN COMMENTS:

Annie Shennett from 39 Highland Avenue wanted to say how pleased she is with the upgrades made at Colson Park. She still has concerns about stray balls coming into her yard and causing damages. Ms. Myers explained to her about the expense of the netting and reassured her that if there are any damages from balls at the park to get in touch with the City and she will take care of it.

The time was noted at 6:45 P.M.

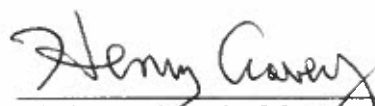
RE-OPEN MEETING:
