

Adopt-A-Pot Form

Downtown Hawkinsville's Main Street Program, along with Hawkinsville Master Gardner's are working hard to beautify Downtown Hawkinsville. Downtown Hawkinsville's Historic District has a collection of 8 big planters, and we need your help to make them beautiful. We are asking businesses, clubs, organizations, or individuals to Adopt-A-Pot in Historic Downtown Hawkinsville and make the heart of our city a little brighter.

Interested? Here are the basics of how it works:

Step 1: Review Adopt-A-Pot Maintenance Requirements

- 1. Plant pots twice a year by April 22, 2023 and October 14, 2023
- 2. Water 3 to 4 days a week
- 3. Dead head and trim flowers
- 4. Fertilize when needed
- 5. Weed
- 6. & anything else to keep plants in tip top shape

Step 3: A representative from the Hawkinsville-Pulaski County Economic Development and Main Street Office will contact you to let you know where your pot's location is and that your application has been approved.

Step 4: Plant & maintain your pot twice a year by April 22, 2023 and October 14, 2023. Because of your pot adoption, you will also be eligible to participate in the Downtown Hawkinsville Planter Contests for your pots design. The 2023 Spring Planter Contest deadline to participate is April 22, 2023, and the theme is Spring Explosion. The 2023 Fall Planter Contest deadline to participate is October 14, 2023, and the theme is Monster Mash.
