

Call for Special Election

Notice is hereby given that, in accordance with O.C.G.A. § 21-2-540, a special election shall be held in Pulaski County to fill the vacancy in the office of Pulaski County Board of Education District 2, caused by the resignation of the Honorable Greg Brown. The special election will be held on May 21, 2024.

Qualifying for the special election shall be held at the Board of Elections and Registration, beginning at 9:00 a.m. on March 4 and ending at noon on March 8, 2024. The qualifying fee shall be \$90.00.

All persons who are not registered to vote and who desire to register to vote in the special election may register to vote through the close of business on April 22, 2024.

Early voting will be held April 29, 2024 through May 17, 2024. Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on Election Day.

Should a runoff election be required, such runoff will be held on June 18, 2024.
