

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-11

BY THE PULASKI COUNTY COMMISSIONER

Local State of Emergency

WHEREAS: The County of Pulaski, Georgia may experience an event of Critical significance as a result of Hurricane Helene on the 26-27th day of September 2024, and;

WHEREAS: There may exist emergency circumstances requiring extraordinary and immediate corrective acts for the protection of the health and safety of the citizens of the County of Pulaski, and,

WHEREAS: To prevent or minimize injury to people and damage to property resulting from this event,

NOW THEREFORE: *The County of Pulaski declares that a local state of emergency exists.*

IT IS ORDERED that the County of Pulaski Emergency Management Agency activate the county Emergency Operations Plan, and the emergency management ordinances adopted by the Pulaski County Commission be operative.

IT IS IT FURTHER ORDERED That a daily curfew is established restricting travel from 10:00p on September 26th until 6:00a on September 27th with the exception of persons traveling to and from work and for healthcare; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that during the curfew, the following persons are exempted and free to travel to carry out their duties: police officers, firefighters, active duty military, health care providers, and public works and utility workers employed by any public utility, any municipality or local Government, the State of Georgia and the United States of America. Additionally, exemptions are granted to persons traveling to and from work or a medical facility, traveling through Pulaski County to a destination outside the County and making deliveries within Pulaski County, Citizens seeking to restore order to their homes or businesses while on their own property or place of business; Other authorized and essential persons as designated on a list compiled by Pulaski County Emergency Management Agency.

Resolved, adopted and effective this 26th day of September 2024.
