The regular meeting of the Pulaski County Commissioner was held at 10:00 a.m. on May 6th, 2024. Commissioner Mashburn led the Pledge of Allegiance and Maggie Bloodworth gave the invocation.

The AirMedCare Network agreement with Pulaski County was signed. This provides employees the opportunity to make payroll deductions to pay for service.

The Pulaski County Transit Drug & Alcohol testing policy to amend Department of Transportation guidelines was updated and signed.

The Proclamation for National Hospital week for May 12-18 was signed.

The Proclamation for Older Adults Month for May 2024 was signed.

The Behavioral Health Contract with Community Service Board of Middle Georgia, an ongoing contract to supplement mental health services, was signed.

The yearly Service Agreement with Cobra Exterminating Co. for the Senior Center was signed.

Commissioner Mashburn introduced the new Chamber President, Jeremy King. Mr. King presented the Chamber report.

Commissioner Mashburn reported for Economic Development that the Fair building will have a ribbon cutting on 5/7 at 6pm. There are three new apartments, two are already leased and one will be furnished and used for extended stays.
