The regular meeting of the Pulaski County Commissioner was held at 10:00 a.m. on January 6th, 2025. Commissioner Mashburn led the Pledge of Allegiance and gave the invocation.

The Commissioner made new Central Georgia Joint Development Authority appointments.

The Purchase agreement with Scruggs Company for sand mining operations was signed.

The Hargray contract for a new Transit phone line was signed.

The Intergovernmental Agreement for Animal Control Services with the City of Hawkinsville was signed.

The Intergovernmental Agreement for Law Enforcement Services with the City of Hawkinsville was signed.

The Commissioner recorded the Appointment of Magistrate Heather Horton.

The Pulaski County Personnel Policies & Procedures were updated as of January 6th, 2025, to reflect changes to sick leave and holidays.

Resolution 2025-1 Borrowing Resolution was signed.

Resolution 2025-2 Official Depository was signed.

Jamie McDonald presented the Economic Development report.

Terry Hood asked how many boards there were in the County. The Commissioner listed the Board of Assessors, Equalization, Elections, Recreation, Health, DFACS and the Development Authority. All of these boards are for operations, not fiscal decisions. The Hospital Authority does not fall under the county.

Jamie McDonald reported that the Development Authority was reactivated in 2024. Members were trained and by-laws were created.
