Minutes of Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of the Pulaski County Commissioner was held at 10:00 a.m. on September 8, 2025. Commissioner Mashburn led the Pledge of Allegiance and gave the invocation.

The Memorandum of Understanding between University of Georgia Cooperative Extension and Pulaski County was signed.

The Resolution 2025-4 Minimum County Contribution for Cooperative Extension Support was signed.

The I3 Verticals, LLC Master Agreement for Tag Reader software for Sheriff Department was approved.

The Agreement with Symphona, LLP to audit financial statements for 2023 was approved.

The Hargray Lease cancellation as of 9/30/25 for Emergency Callworks equipment was entered into the record.

The Resolution 2025-5 Authorizing the Filing of 5311 Grant with Department of Transportation for Transit Services was signed.

Lynn Johnson gave the Chamber of Commerce report. She stated that RiverFest was a success and new business, Judy's Bistro, was doing very well.

Jamie McDonald gave the Economic Development report.

Commissioner Mashburn gave kudos to the Sherriff's office for the increase in citations written. This revenue helped to purchase the new tag reader. She also spoke about the Flock cameras that will be purchased for \$3000 each.

Commissioner Mashburn stated that our county patrols are working with the Department of Corrections to patrol around Pulaski State Prison. They will concentrate outside the perimeter to intercept contraband.

Mr. Quick asked questions about how much the tag reader cost. Mr. Quick also asked if there were any Salvation Army drop boxes in the County. The Commissioner stated she did not know of any.
