Minutes of Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of the Pulaski County Commissioner was held at 10:00 a.m. on October 6, 2025. Commissioner Mashburn led the Pledge of Allegiance and Maggie Bloodworth gave the invocation.

- Commissioner Mashburn approved the rezoning request for Parcel T1073090001 from I-A: County Intensive Agriculture to R: County Residential
- Sheriff Wiley signed a contract with Flock Safety for the purchase of eight cameras to monitor tags and car make/models.
- Sheriff Wiley signed an agreement with Kellwell Food Management to provide meals for the County Jail.
- Commissioner Mashburn approved the Recreation Department Board term appointments.
- Commissioner Mashburn signed the New York Life Employer Agreement Form for employee deductions for elective life insurance. There is no cost to the County and open enrollment is in November.
- The Fire Department was awarded a \$5000 AgGeorgia Farm Credit 2025 Community Mission Fund Grant to equip brush trucks with essential firefighting tools to improve wildfire response.
- Commissioner Mashburn approved the request of Maggie Bloodworth, coordinator of Family Connections, for funding support of \$5600 to strengthen critical services.
- Lynn Johnson presented the Chamber of Commerce report. The Chamber awards dinner will be held November 20th. There will be a Veterans Day ceremony at the park and small flags can be purchased for \$5 at the local banks.
- Jamie McDonald presented the Economic Development report. The new sign is in place at the corner of Broad & Lumpkin St. A façade grant was awarded to Vital Tea Nutrition on Commerce St.
- Ms. Jelks asked for assistance with roads on Davis Rd to clean out a pipe and pull the ditches. She also requested Deer Crossing and Slow Down signs for Lampkin Smith Rd to help prevent accidents. Mr. Mifflin asked about a sign and guard rails on the creek new Kitchen Bottom Rd. Commissioner Mashburn will let the road department about both situations.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:39.
