Minutes of Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of the Pulaski County Commissioner was held at 10:00 a.m. on May 11, 2026. Commissioner Mashburn called the meeting to order, gave the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

New Business – The quote from The Supreme Corporation for twenty-one new bulletproof vests for the Sheriff's Department was approved. The total cost is \$30,177, with \$22,100 to be reimbursed by the City of Hawkinsville.

The One Step GPS Contract for twenty devices for Sheriff Department vehicles was approved.

The annual renewal for Behavioral Health contract for the Community Service Board of Middle Georgia was approved.

The contract with Ford Motor Credit for three Ford Explorer Interceptor vehicles for the Sheriff's Department over a four-year term was approved.

The annual renewal for the Pulaski County Insurance Plan was approved. The County will change to UnitedHealthcare at a decreased rate of 5.9%.

The Memorandum of Understanding (MOA) between Middle Georgia Regional Commission and Pulaski County for Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan was signed. The project completion date is May 2027.

The TimeClock Plus Contract for Implementation and Licenses for 60 months was approved and signed.

Resolution 2026-5 for Certified County Official Supplement for Laurie Obert-Thorn was approved.

The Purchasing Lease Agreement with Pitney Bowes Financial Services, LLC was approved and will begin July 2026.

Jamie McDonald presented the Economic Development report. One of the items highlighted was in regard to maintenance issues in the downtown area. The City has begun sending letters outlining maintenance and upkeep guidelines to businesses in an effort to encourage compliance and help avoid fines.

Public Comments – The Sheriff reported that he participated in mock interviews at the local high school. He also reported that the department has two new deputies — one mandate graduate and one new hire — as well as one recruit who is currently attending mandate training.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:20. Present at this meeting were Commissioner Mashburn, Jamie McDonald, Ronnie Quick, Sheriff Wayne Wiley, Francis Walker and Laurie Obert-Thorn.
